

GBWGC TREASURER'S REPORT 2022-23

The GBWGC has ended the year with \$848 in the kitty thanks to income from:

- \$20 per head player subscriptions (\$200);
- Player levies of \$2 per player at Hamersley (\$268);
- Binningup surpluses, mainly Sports Cards (\$280);
- Mornington 8 surplus (\$150).

Expenditure was limited to:

- Cart subsidies at Joondalup (\$180);
- Subsidies at Mornington 8 (\$739).

There was an increased attendance at games from 176 player-games in 2021-22 to 187 in 2022-23, this season's numbers not including Peter Crow's attendance. Interesting to note that at the 8 'away' games there was a total of 53 player-games only a slightly higher average attendance than at home games, a similar average to season 2021-22.

Some questions for discussion:

*Should annual player subscriptions remain at \$20 per head for the season?

Note that the cost of (concession) games at Hamersley has increased from \$18 to \$20 per head so the levies of \$268 in 2022-23 from charging \$20 per head will not accrue in the coming season. I suggest there is no need for an increase.

*Notwithstanding the price increase mentioned above I propose from a practical viewpoint we continue to collect \$20 per player for Hamersley home games in season 2023-24.

*Are there any comments on expenditure in 2022-23? Any subsidies paid out were based on discussion with a quorum of available members and with the criterion that every club member had equal access to any subsidy.

*Are there any extraordinary costs likely to arise in season 2023-24? Are there any suggestions for possible club expenditure in the coming season?
