- The closing comment at Squancey's 200th game presentation back in January 2020 was "With such youth and determination on the side of financial accounting's answer to Benjamin Button, 300 games is inevitable". And so it has come to pass.
- Our one time 'journeyman' and now Perth-based and much sought after financial and technology guru has racked up another 100 games with an impressive average of 28 games per season over the last three seasons.
- Squancey is a truly great clubman. He has willingly leapt into assisting with catering for Binningup events, and his speed in setting in train accommodation arrangements for Mornington Masters 8 ensured that fantastic trip was a fait accompli.
- But we also know he's no slouch when it comes to swinging the hickory. Squancey doesn't hold back, either with his cracking drives and thumping irons or with his powerful shouts of disdain (to put it mildly) at errant shots or missed putts.
- His competitive nature has earned success in 10 of the major awards and achieved 22 Award successes.
- His achievements include 2 Consistency and 3 Eclectic Awards and he has 4 Nearest the Pin Awards and 3 Long Drive Awards having been dominant in each category over the last 5 seasons.
- Has 2 Masters Jacket successes, winning his first in 2018-19 with a record 41 points in a dominating season. His Golden Putter success in 2015-16 recorded the second lowest number of putts for a qualifying round and for total putts.
- His other Award successes have been:
 - the Binningup Open (twice);
 - the Joondalup Classic (equal highest number of wins – 2);
 - the Handicapper's Trophy (twice); and
 - the Inaugural South West Masters.
- You have to admire this early bird considering the distance he is required to travel to most courses and the way he balances the competing requirements of golf and the demands of a busy job.
